**Public Comment**

Ms. Sauer also suggested the village research the possibility of heated sidewalks in front of local businesses to help aid with snow removal.

**Update on Community Marketing and Aesthetics**

Assistant Village Manager Jarr also updated the CRC on the addition of the community marketing site to the village's website. Utilizing the GIS system, the new feature highlights commercial properties that are available in the community. Village staff had discussed promoting the new feature in the Rose Clippings and potentially creating a spotlight on the village's main page of the website. Ms. Sauer stated she could put information regarding the new online feature in the Chamber's newsletter.
