Julia Reven made a *Motion: To Approve the Five Year Plan FY 22/23-26/27*. The motion was seconded by Jakub Myers. Upon conclusion of the discussion, there was consensus to approve both motions.

8. Confirm Interest in Re-Appointment

Maggie Jarr noted that three seniors will be graduating this spring: Julia Reven, Will Aikens, and Charlotte Sands. Several Commissioners have a term expiring in 2022 and Maggie Jarr asked for those in attendance to confirm their interest in being reappointed. Audrey Topazian, Owen Myers, and Sophie Marczuk expressed interest being reappointed and continuing to serve on the Youth Commission.

Maggie Jarr provided information on two upcoming community events. Community Volunteer Day will take place on Saturday, May 14, 9:00 a.m.-Noon and Commissioners were encouraged to register online and help promote the event.
