**7. Review of Village Board Work Session Meeting of May 8, 2018**

Clark Andersen summarized the Village Board Agenda Memo Amendments to Liquor Regulations-Hours of Sale. At the end of discussion there was a *Consensus to approve an Ordinance Amending Chapter 112 of Title XI of the LaGrange Park Municipal Code Regulating Liquor Sales and Licenses.*

Clark Andersen summarized the Village Board Agenda Memo regarding 2018/19-MFT General Maintenance Resolution. At the end of discussion there was a *Consensus to approve the motion approving a "Resolution for Maintenance of Streets and Highways by Municipality under the Illinois Highway Code" for the expenditure of \$261,000 in MFT Funds.*

Clark Andersen summarized the Village Board Agenda Memo regarding Sherwood Road Resurfacing. At the end of discussion there was a *Consensus to approve the motion (1) approving the IDOT Local Public Agency Agreement for Federal Participation, and (2) Approving a Resolution for appropriation of funds for the purpose of paying for local agency share for construction for Sherwood Road improvements.*

Clark Andersen summarized Village Board Memo regarding Commission Appointments-2018. At the end of discussion *there was a Consensus to Approve Committee and Commission Appointments and Reappointments as follows; (1)Maureen Ventura to fill the vacancy to serve the remaining term until May 2021 on the Planning & Zoning Commission (2)Chmn Steve May, Paul Graham, Brian Lisek, Keith Krysa, and Eric Johnson, re-appointed to the Traffic, Safety & Engineering Committee and Ryan Vokac, and Brian Sok newly appointed to the Committee, all for a 2-year term expiring in 2020 (3)Donald Veverka re-appointed to a new 3-year term expiring in 2021 to the Board of Police Commissioners (4) Michael Sabella re-appointed to a new 2-year term expiring in 2020 to the Police Pension Board.*

With no further business to come before the Commission, *there was a motion to adjourn by Clark Andersen. The motion to adjourn was seconded by Julia Reven and passed unanimously by voice vote.*
