Village Market Streetscape Improvement Plan –Presentation of Draft Plan


Franny Ritchie, Project Manager, presented a PowerPoint to discuss the draft Village Market Streetscape Improvement Plan. The presentation included the project history and a description of the site area. The planning process utilized two public meetings and a community survey, which indicated that safety was a primary priority regarding the plan. Additionally, the community preferred a more traditional design style, as opposed to a contemporary design style, overall.

The presentation also touched on IDOT meeting takeaways, key recommendations and proposed intersection improvements within the study area, on-street and off-street bicycle path options along Harding Avenue, district branding and identity, and immediate actions for plan implementation.

After the presentation and discussion, the CRC supported making a recommendation to the Village Board to accept the Village Market Streetscape Improvement Plan at the March work session meeting.
