**Approval of Minutes – February 8, 2023**

*Trustee Stewart moved to approve the February 8, 2023, CRC meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Trustee Sheehan and passed unanimously by voice vote.*

**Village Market Streetscape Improvement Plan – Update & Next Steps**

Deputy Village Manager Jarr updated the CRC on the Village Market Streetscape Improvement Plan. Deputy Village Manager Jarr discussed the grant application that staff had filed with Cook County requesting \$575,000 to help fund the construction and improvements on Homestead between La Grange Road and Sherwood. The grant would come from the Invest in Cook fund and staff anticipates a decision by July of 2023. Deputy Village Manager Jarr also provided an update on IDOT and their work with the project. IDOT representatives had toured the area and expressed a commitment to look at the village's plan and vet if variations to the normal solutions for the area would be warranted and acceptable. The Vulnerable Road Assessment tool was reviewed with the CRC and staff will advertise its use in an upcoming e-briefs. Staff have also budgeted for a market study specifically focusing on the property area on north La Grange Road where Jiffy Lube and the Superior Cleaners are located.


**Light Pole Banners – Discussion of Summer Design**
