Public Participation (Agenda and Non-Agenda Related)

Katherine Padgett, Executive Director of the La Grange Area Historical Society addressed the board to inform and invite them to several exciting events they have planned for the month.

Aidan Joyce from Representative Rashid's office addressed the Board. He discussed the recent Disaster Proclamation for flooding issued by the Governor. He offered Representative Rashid's support to our Village and is looking forward to developing a strong relationship with our Village.

Public Works Committee Items

After a discussion regarding the succession of vehicles within the Public Works Department, Trustee Sheehan made a motion *To Authorize Staff To Purchase A 2024 GMC 2500 HD Pickup Truck With Snow Plow And A GMC 1500 Pickup Truck From Coffman Truck Sales Inc. For \$105,774.20.* Trustee Zaura seconded the motion and it passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Other Reports

President Discipio called upon Village Manager Cedillo for a report. Village Manager Cedillo discussed three items. The Village has been working diligently to secure funding for the Central Area Storm Water Area Project. Recently, the Village was informed that they did not receive Congressional appropriation at this time. However, President Discipio and Village Manager Cedillo have been meeting with Representatives and are looking at potential lobbying options. She also reported that the Village is holding second round interviews for the part-time position of Senior Planner. Additionally, President Discipio and Manager Cedillo will be attending the IML Summer Conference in River Forest.

President Discipio called upon Deputy Village Clerk Bakalich for a report. There was nothing to report.

President Discipio had one item to report on. He mentioned that he recently met with Representative Garcia and he was appreciative of him reaching out and meeting.
