Rebuild Illinois - Application Process





- Two grants submissions of behalf of the Village
 - Fast-Track Competitive Public Infrastructure
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- Fast - Track
 - \$25,000,000 available
 - Grant amounts - \$500,000 up to \$5,000,000
 - "Shovel Ready" construction to begin within 90 days of award.
- Competitive Public Infrastructure
 - Grant amounts - \$250,000 up to \$5,000,000
 - Construction within 24 months, with a one time extension of up to 12 months.

Rebuild Illinois - Project Overview



- Street Rehabilitation - Resurfacing
 - Meadowcrest - 31st to 29th Street
 - Woodside - Meadowcrest to 29th
 - 28th - between Forest and Homestead
 - 26th Street - Kemman to Maple
- These street were originally chosen as all roadways North of 31st were originally located in an “underserved” area outlined by CMAP and would have gained a much higher scoring. A week or so after the application process came out, CMAP reclassified the area and these streets are no longer within the “underserved” area.
