GREEN ELECTRIC AGGREGATION NOTICE

Dear Resident or Small Business Owner:

The Village of La Grange Park selected Chicago-based MC Squared Energy Services, LLC (mc²), to serve the Village with electricity supply for the Green Electric Aggregation Program. mc² will provide eligible residents and small businesses with an electric supply price equal to the ComEd rate during the remaining 18-month term of the electric aggregation program through November 2024. **The program provides the Village with Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) at zero added cost to residents and the Village.** Through the program, the Village has earned recognition as an EPA Green Power Community.

You are not required to do anything to participate. mc² will automatically process your enrollment and acquire RECs on behalf of the Village, based on your historical electric consumption. **You will pay the exact same rate as the published monthly ComEd rate. There are never any added fees: no enrollment fees, nor early termination fees.** If you are, or plan to participate in a community solar savings program, this electricity aggregation program will not impact your community solar program. Community solar generation credits provided by ComEd are independent of the aggregation program.

Opt-Out Option: You have twenty-one (21) days from the date on this notice to opt out. You may opt out by calling 855-564-8129, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. or returning the enclosed card by March 29, 2023. If you do not opt-out of the Village's Green Electric Aggregation Program, you will be deemed to have authorized and agreed to your enrollment in the electric aggregation program, and to have your electricity service with mc² under the enclosed Terms and Conditions and the Uniform Disclosure Statement.

You may purchase electric supply from other Retail Electricity Suppliers or ComEd. For a complete list of your options, visit www.pluginillinois.org. Billing and Service: Your billing and service will remain the same. You will continue to receive a monthly invoice from ComEd. ComEd continues to be responsible for wires, poles, and all emergencies, including outage restoration.


