Re: Fire Department Activities – APRIL 2023

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of April. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 144. There have been 608 YTD compared to 570 YTD in 2022.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 47. There have been 172 YTD compared to 151 YTD in 2022.

Many training events took place during the month. Personnel were trained by our vendor on the operations and proper use of our new SCBA's. We also utilized the exteriors of the vacant 5/3 bank and Loyola buildings to train on deploying ladders and hose lines. Some of our firefighters also participated in live fire training at the Romeoville Fire Academy organized by MABAS Division 10. Two of our Haz-Mat techs also participate in training on lithium-ion battery fires. A couple of our personnel also attended FDIC International in Indianapolis.

Personnel conducted a fire drill at Brook Park School, and also participated in a career day for the LADSE school at the St. Louise De Marillac building.

Fire sprinkler inspections and pressure tests continued for the Plymouth Place project. Changes were made to the design of dry sprinkler systems in three of the building's attics, so new plans were submitted for review.

A final sprinkler inspection was conducted and approved for the new home at 302 N. Kensington.

Incidents of Note

Saturday, 4/15, 9:41 pm - Response to investigate smoke in a house in the 1200 blk of Robinhood. The cause appeared to be related to power for a ceiling fan.

Monday, 4/17, 3:24 am - Response to a utility pole on fire in the 1100 blk of Morgan. Firefighters stood-by and put water on garages where burning embers were dropping until ComEd could cut power to the pole, and firefighters could extinguish the pole fire.

Sunday, 4/23, 4:35 am - Response to assist Summit with station coverage during an apartment fire.

Wednesday, 4/26, 10:28 am - Response to a gas leak cause by tree planting at 340 N. Brainard.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – APRIL 2023

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 144 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 148 patients. There were 115 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 17 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 12 times and received it 12 times. Year to date there has been a total of 608 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 632 patients.

This compares to last year (April 2022) when there were 122 requests for service treating 133 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

Paramedic Continuing Education this month will be on May 8, 9, and 10th at 9am in LaGrange Park Fire Department.

EMT-B Continuing Education will be May 9th at 7pm in the basement of station one.

Special Activities:

Friday: EMS Recognition Day







La Grange Park Fire History...

Sept. 11th 1937 - May 4th 1999





