


Re: Fire Department Activities – MARCH 2023

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of March. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 171. This compares to March 2022, when there were 148.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 44. This compares to March 2022, when there were 36.

After a lot of work put in by many personnel, our new Engine 1221 was officially placed in service. Personnel will continue to train with it to get more proficient on its operation.

The Foreign Fire Insurance Board met during the month. Of note was the approval of Rapid Intervention Packs, new tools for Fire Station No. 1, and a partial boot allowance for personnel.

Personnel provided a CPR class to employees of Webster Dental and The Montessori Children's Place, and also participated in the Ready Teddy Open House. They also attended a Heart-Fest event at Ogden Avenue School providing CPR demonstrations and discussing symptoms of stroke, and the Fire Chief provided a presentation to Cub Scout Pack 66 regarding his role in government for one of their requirements for Arrow of Light.

Ambulance 1214 crash repairs were completed, and it appears to have come out nice. After being thoroughly cleaned and stocked, it was placed back in service.

Following Village Board approval, the order was placed for new SCBA's.

FSCI (our fire code consultants) and the Fire Chief conducted the first set of hydrostatic pressure testing of sprinkler piping at the new construction at Plymouth Place, at building C, and all went well.

Personnel participated in the Andy's Frozen Custard Ribbon Cutting and Golden Scoop event.

MABAS Haz-Mat team personnel participated BioWatch training instructed by FEMA.

The Fire Chief participated in the Triton College Emergency Services Advisory Board meeting which was attended by the Triton College president.

Sunday, 3/05, 8:48 am - Response to 7-11 for smoking power strip under front counter.

Monday, 3/20, 1:42 pm - Response to wires arcing/burning on the Village water tower.

Wednesday, 3/29, 8:31 am - Response to Plymouth Place construction site for contractor who fell on 2nd floor of one of the buildings and sustained a significant arm injury.

Friday, 3/31, 8:52 pm - Response with Engine 1211 for smoke in a home on Blackstone in La Grange during a power outage; their FD was tied up on another incident at the hospital. Our personnel discovered a burnt power strip in the home.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – MARCH 2023

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 171 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 179 patients. There were 143 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 14 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 14 times and received it 22 times. Year to date there has been a total of 464 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 484 patients.

This compares to last year (March 2022) when there were 148 requests for service treating 151 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

Probationary Firefighter Mike Clapsaddle passed his national EMT-B exam and will be the taking Loyola System test entry in the next couple weeks.

Mandatory Continuing Education (CE) for Paramedics and EMT-B's was conducted in the second week of March. The topic was stroke emergencies.

April CE for EMT-B's is scheduled for Tuesday, April 11, 2023 at 7pm in the community room. April CE for paramedics is scheduled on the following days; Wednesday 10/12 at 0900, Thursday 10/13 at 0900, and Friday 10/14 at 0900.

Special Activities:

On Friday, March 3rd, Firefighter/Paramedic Nick Ausmann and Firefighter/EMT-B Mike Hughes provided CPR certification and training to seven employees from Webster Dental at 539 N LaGrange Rd.

On Friday, March 25th, Firefighter/Paramedic Patrick Shields and Firefighter/EMT-B Mike Hughes provided CPR certification and training for four employees at the Montessori Children's Place at 1130 N Maple.

Prevention Activities of Note

Panera: Series of smoke detector activations have occurred due to baking. Activations occur on detectors adjacent to oven, when oven is being operated at 420F or above. Continued investigation as to remedy.

555 Kensington: 3/15 demolition company damaged the fire alarm. Chief Maggos and Captain Fagan met with owner to assure safety during decommissioning of building and demolition.

1140 Maple: Inspector Gruszka followed up 1/12/23 and discovered non-permitted work had been done to repair the structure and the fire alarm from a vehicle striking the building. Also, it was discovered that new tenant had moved into the space without a business license and will be occupying building. Plans have been submitted for the work, and we are requiring a new exit door to be installed at the rear of the building due to travel distance issues; plans have been submitted for that also.
