Re: Fire Department Activities – FEBRUARY 2023

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of February. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 152. This compares to February 2022, when there were 134.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 43. This compares to February 2022, when there were 31.

Staff worked hard throughout the month completing various tasks in order to prepare our new Engine 1221 for service; including but not limited to having radio work completed, hose covers installed, installing mounting brackets for equipment, and driving and training with the Engine. Towards the end of the month, Engine 1222, our 1992 fire apparatus, was taken out of service for the transfer of equipment. Firefighters worked throughout the last weekend of the month, and several additional days, transferring and mounting tools, hose and equipment onto the new engine.

Staff was notified by FEMA that our 2021 Assistance to Fire Grant application was awarded, which was written and submitted in February 2022. The amount awarded is \$233,024.28, which is to be used for the purchase of new SCBA's and new STARCUM mobile radios for our fire apparatus. A new grant application was also submitted which also included some replacement communication headsets.

Ambulance 1214 remained out of service throughout the month, as repairs were being made to it at Rock River Auto Body, in Sterling, IL. This shop was chosen as they specialize in ambulance repairs, and are under the ownership of the vendor whom we purchased the ambulance new from.

A few personnel participated in the annual Mighty Patriots Heroes vs. Heroes game. The Mighty Patriots are the Special Olympic basketball team from Park Jr. High.

The Foreign Fire Insurance Board met, approving tools for Station 1, a partial boot allowance for personnel, and to split the cost of new Rapid Intervention Packs with the Foundation.

Staff met with our GIS Consortium to outline and discuss prioritizing GIS projects that would benefit the Fire Department.

Paramedic/Firefighters Schattauer and Shield completed CPR Instructor certification.

On Friday, February 3rd, at 10:34 am, the FD responded to a natural gas leak in a home in the 1400 block of Cleveland. It occurred after a small fire was put out in the fireplace. The FD isolated leak by turning off gas.

On the afternoons of February 14th and 21st, the FD responded to brush and waste fires at Brezina Woods.

On Wednesday, February 22nd at 6:36 am, the FD responded with the Chief and an Engine to assist Brookfield with an apartment fire at 4509 Elm Ave. The engine stood by at their Fire Station No. 1.



EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – FEBRUARY 2023

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 152 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 161 patients. There were 124 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 18 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 10 times and received it 15 times. Year to date there has been a total of 293 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 305 patients.

This compares to last year (February 2022) when there were 134 requests for service treating 165 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

Probationary Firefighter Mike Clapsaddle passed his national EMT-B exam and will be the taking Loyola System test entry in the next couple weeks.

Mandatory Continuing Education (CE) for Paramedics and EMT-B's was conducted in the second week of February. The topic was cardiac emergencies.

March CE for paramedics is scheduled for March 13th, 15th and 17th from 9am until 11am at the LaGrange Park Fire Department (Community Room). CE for EMT-B's is set for next week, March 14th in the Community Room at 7pm.

FF/PM's Spencer Schattauer and Patrick Shields completed their CPR Instructor Certification training and are now able to operate as an American Heart Association licensed Instructor.
