HOW TO REQUEST A PUBLIC RECORD PURSUANT TO THE ILLINOIS FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

Any person or entity requesting a public record from the Village must submit a written request. To help ensure thorough and efficient processing, requesters are encouraged to submit their requests using the Village's FOIA Request Form, including the Village's online FOIA Request Form for electronic submissions or the FOIA Request Form (PDF) for requests submitted by mail or in person. Each requester should clearly state and describe the records requested in sufficient detail to enable Village staff to locate the records. The Village will respond in writing within five (5) business days after receipt of a compliant request, unless an extension is permitted by law. FOIA requests submitted by mail or in person should be directed to:



GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE VILLAGE OF LA GRANGE PARK, ILLINOIS (PROVIDED PURSUANT TO 5 ILCS 140/4)

The Village of La Grange Park (the "Village") is a non-home rule municipal corporation located in west Cook County in Northeast Illinois. It provides local governmental services to the residents of the Village of La Grange Park, including public safety (Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services) Water and Sewer service, streets and urban forest services, planning and zoning regulation, economic development and building permits. The Village strives to serve its residents efficiently and expeditiously.

RECORDS NOT REQUIRING A FOIA REQUEST

The following is a list of documents that do not require the submission of a FOIA request and will be granted on site to the requester: Village Board Agendas and Minutes, Village Ordinances, Village Resolutions, Proclamations, the Municipal Code, Annual Budgets, Village Newsletters, Audits, Five Year Plans, Total Compensation Reports, Treasurer's Reports, Collective Bargaining Agreements. ALLOWABLE FEES UNDER FOIA (5 ILCS 140/6)

In certain circumstances, public entities may charge a fee for the production of public records. Some common examples include: After the first 50 pages, black and white letter or legal-sized copies shall be \$0.15 per page. Color copies or copies in a size other than letter or legal shall be no more than the actual cost of reproducing the requested records. Electronic copies requested shall be the actual cost of purchasing the recording medium. The cost for certifying a record shall not exceed \$1.00.
