Re: Fire Department Activities – MARCH 2025

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of March. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 178. There have been 559 YTD compared to 464 YTD in 2024.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 65. There have been 166 YTD compared to 137 YTD in 2024.

Firefighter/Paramedic Ullrich gave CPR and First-Aid training to Little League coaches and staff.

FD personnel hosted a Fire Station tour for Daisy Girl Scouts.

On March 7th PSI Paramedic/Firefighter Jake Wiener graduated from the fire academy.

We have been requested to begin responding with our ladder truck to Western Springs north of 47th St., for all structural related calls (fire alarms, smoke scares, and fires).

FD personnel installed an AED on the lower level of the Village Hall.

Our hydraulic rescue tools underwent annual inspection and testing. A few repairs were made.

A special meeting and election were held for a vacancy on our Foreign Fire Insurance Board.

Anthony Zito passed Probation, and was sworn in as a POC Firefighter. Captain Chris Baudler and Lieutenant Evan Lilly were also formally sworn into their new promoted positions.

New permanent door signage was installed at both fire stations.

Incidents of Interest

On Saturday March 15th at 12:18 pm, we responded with and Engine and Chief to assist Brookfield with a fire at Off Broadway Pub, at 9048 Monroe. The fire was confined to some stud spaces inside the front wall of the business.

On Sunday March 16th at 6:17 pm, we responded to a report of smoke in a home in the 1100 block of Ostrander. Upon arrival and investigation fire companies found everyone out of the home, and a fire burning inside the furnace, spreading heavy smoke throughout the home. Firefighters extinguished the fire and were able to rescue a pet cat.



EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – March 2025

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 178 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 174 patients. There were 139 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 27 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 12 times and received it 18 times. Year to date there has been a total of 559 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 550 patients.

This compares to last year (March 2024) when there were 142 requests for service treating 142 patients and year to date totals were 464 requests for service treating 461 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

All Paramedics and EMT's completed a mandatory Ce online through the Loyola Moodle.

Special Activities:

FF/Paramedic Maddie Uilrich provided CPR and First aid to the LaGrange Park Little League coaches/staff at the LaGrange Park, Park District building on March 24th 2025.
