Re: Fire Department Activities – JUNE 2025

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of June. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 164. There have been 1,070 YTD compared to 951 YTD in 2024.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 76. There have been 364 YTD compared to 303 YTD in 2024.

The Daytime Staffing program began this month, with three additional personnel staffing the station from 8am-4pm weekdays. During such shifts, a great deal of time is being put into training, and equipment and vehicle checks, while also providing for more immediate response.

Personnel conducted training with Indiana Harbor Belt Railroad Safety and Haz-Mat representatives, who provided important safety info. about railroad operations and equipment.

Chief Maggos participated in Full-Scale Active Shooter Training at a school in Western Springs. Multiple police and fire agencies from the area participated, and many lessons were learned.

Staff met with a representative from the Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal, who conducted an audit of records related to training reimbursements we have applied for.

Personnel assisted with the Wounded Warrior Soldier Ride, displaying the flag from our ladder truck.

Personnel participated in their annual NFPA medical evaluations during the month.

Paramedic Diamond Trueba was welcomed as a new Full-Time PSI paramedic during the month.

Personnel completed the remodeling project of our Fire Station 1 Watch Office. Most of the work was done by PSI Paramedic/Firefighters Jim Tolf and Paul Eggerding, and much while on-duty.

UL conducted annual aerial ladder inspection and testing, and testing of fire apparatus pumps.

Incidents of Interest

On Monday June 2nd at 8:24 pm, personnel responded to a two-vehicle rollover crash at La Grange and Harding.

On Sunday June 15th at 10:31 pm, Chief 1201 responded as the Safety Section Officer to a house fire in Hinsdale.

On Sunday June 22nd at 10:06 pm, Truck 1219 responded to Bedford Park to help cover their Village during a high-angle technical rescue at Seat Geek Stadium during a summer festival.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – June 2025

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 164 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 168 patients. There were 121 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 22 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 22 times and received it 15 times. Year to date there has been a total of 1,070 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 1,064 patients.

This compares to last year (June 2024) when there were 174 requests for service treating 179 patients and year to date totals were 951 requests for service treating 962 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

The LaGrange Park Fire Department began operating a day-time staff Monday-Friday consisting of 3 additional personnel in addition to the two contracted paramedics. Crews train regularly during the day working to improve their emergency medical technician skills.


