Re: Fire Department Activities – JULY 2025

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of July. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 184. There have been 1,254 YTD compared to 1,110 YTD in 2024.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 81. There have been 445 YTD compared to 372 YTD in 2024.

Personnel assisted with a day camp program held at Forest Rd. School.

Personnel participated in three Independence Day parades in neighboring communities.

Captain Fagan was awarded a Service Award for 25 years with the Department.

Personnel completed their drivers training course throughout the month.

Department Hazardous Materials Technicians participated in training with the USEPA.

A contractor removed contents left behind at 1024 Newberry as part of preparing for fire training.

A Project Kick-Off meeting was held virtually with our Emergency Operations Plan consultant.

The Secretary of State conducted an unannounced audit of our FD driver's training records.

Our FD 125th Anniversary Fire Apparatus Muster took place in conjunction the PD car show, and Park District Midsummer Memorial event. The MABAS 10 Mobile Ventilation Unit provided cooling in the extreme heat. We thank the PD for allowing our event to be paired with theirs.

A quarterly meeting of our Foreign Fire Insurance Fund was held late in the month.

Incidents of Interest

The FD responded to 28 calls over the July 4th weekend. Two most likely involved fireworks in La Grange, causing damage to a home and another a dumpster next to a garage. One call in the Village involved two primary lines that came down on a car, causing a power outage, and most likely caused by a mylar balloon.

The FD responded to 11 incidents on July 24th, mostly related to trees and wires down from the storm, and a significant crash on La Grange Rd. with a light pole knocked down. We also assisted La Grange with a couple of calls, including wires and trees on fire, and electrical damage and smoke at the 7-11 on Ogden.

Also during the month, the FD assisted the Pleasantview FPD with garage fires in unincorporated La Grange Highlands, and again assisted La Grange with a significant attic fire from a lightning strike at 1113 S. Waiola.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – July 2025

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 184 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 187 patients. There were 152 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 22 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 10 times and received it 25 times. Year to date there has been a total of 1,254 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 1,251 patients.

This compares to last year (July 2024) when there were 159 requests for service treating 159 patients and year to date totals were 1,110 requests for service treating 1,121 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

There was no continuing education for EMT-Bs and Paramedics in the month of July. Continuing Education for the month of August is as scheduled:

Paramedics August 11th, 13th and 15th at the La Grange Fire Department from 9am until 11am
EMT-Bs August 12th at the La Grange Park Fire Department Community Room from 7pm until 9pm.
