Re: Fire Department Activities – SEPTEMBER 2025

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of SEPTEMBER. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 159. There have been 1,599 YTD compared to 1,414 YTD in 2024.  
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 72. There have been 598 YTD compared to 496 YTD in 2024.

Four of our Candidates have been enrolled and began attending EMT-B program at Loyola Hospital.

Personnel provided EMS coverage for the "Sounds of Summer Concert" at Memorial Park. They have also again been providing coverage for Nazareth Varsity Football games.

Key administrative staff have been involved in weekly training for our new fire reporting software, which needs to be implemented by January 1, 2026.

Several personnel attended a day of live fire training sponsored by MABAS Division 10, at the University of Illinois Fire Service Institute in Champaign.

Personnel have been training on SCBA, search and rescue at the home at 1024 Newberry.

Personnel assisted with Patriot's Day 9/11 ceremony at Memorial Park.

Staff has been conducting meetings and trainings to address a high number of "minor" vehicle crashes involving FD vehicles.

Personnel attended the Park District Touch-a-Truck event.

The Fire Department 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary gathering took place at Hop District.

Staff put in a great amount of time preparing for our ISO PPC survey that took place October 1<sup>st</sup>.

A family type of breakfast gathering took place for Jim Vikidel, who resigned after 15 years. He has taken high level job in his full-time career, which requires he move to Wisconsin.

### **Incidents of Interest**

*On Wednesday September 3<sup>rd</sup> we responded to Pillars for an activated fire alarm. Upon arrival and investigation, we discovered smoke in an unoccupied utility room, and found a burned/melted extension cord. Personnel disconnect power and removed the hazard.*

*On Tuesday September 9<sup>th</sup> at 5:05 am, we responded with an Engine and Chief to a multi-tenant residential fire in the 900 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue in La Grange, with a report of people trapped. Upon arrival heavy fire was showing from the front door of the building. Initial arriving firefighters aggressively attacked the fire, and rescued an elderly male from an upstairs bedroom, unfortunately in full cardiac arrest. Chief 1201 was assigned the Operations Chief, coordinating fire attack and search, and Engine 1211 crew assisted with search, and then roof ventilation.*

## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – September 2025

### Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 159 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 164 patients. There were 127 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 17 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 14 times and received it 17 times. Year to date there has been a total of 1,599 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 1,608 patients.

This compares to last year (September 2024) when there were 150 requests for service treating 141 patients and year to date totals were 1,412 requests for service treating 1,414 patients.

### Training and Continuing Education:

Continuing Education for the month of September was conducted for Paramedics on September 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> at the La Grange Fire Department from 9am until 11am; and for EMT-Bs September 9<sup>th</sup> at the La Grange Park Fire Department Community Room from 7pm until 9pm.

Candidate FF Buckley, Candidate FF Cavanuagh, Candidate FF Moyzis, and Candidate FF Donovan have started the EMT-Basic program at Loyola Hospital.

### Special Activities:

Ambulance 1215 provided ambulance coverage for the Nazareth Academy football game on 09/05/2025 and 09/12/2025. Ambulance 1215 also covered the "Sounds of Summer Concert" at Memorial Park.


