Re: Fire Department Activities – OCTOBER 2025

As requested for insertion into the Village Board meeting agenda packet, the following is a brief summary of Fire Department activity highlights for the month of OCTOBER. As usual, a more comprehensive monthly report is kept within the department for your review.

EMS Incidents this month - 134. There have been 1,733 YTD compared to 1,581 YTD in 2024.
Fire/Rescue Incidents this month - 63. There have been 661 YTD compared to 564 YTD in 2024.

After much preparation, our ISO survey to determine our Property Protection Classification took place on October 1st. Throughout the month more work took place in order to provide additional and updated documentation, which was submitted on October 30th.

In conjunction with Fire Prevention Week, several fire safety public education presentations took place at nearly all schools throughout the month. Also, our Annual Open House took place on October 11th. There was great weather and a great crowd, and we were able to raise \$871.00 for Camp I Am Me, a burn camp for children. Personnel also participated in the annual silent parade, running from Hinsdale to Lisle, which is a dedication to all those who have lost their lives to fire.

A lot of training took place during the month, including but not limited to the following: personnel continued training at 1024 Newberry; fire apparatus operator re-certification training was conducted; FF/EMT Veronica Gussie attended the Fire Service Women of IL Training event held at the U of I Fire Service Institute in Champaign; personnel conducted vehicle extrication training, and personnel participated in a multi-faceted training exercise involving Rescue Task Force and Hazardous Materials Team Responses in Hinsdale, simulating an active shooter and drug lab explosion with multiple victims.

Recruitment efforts continued with another interest/orientation meeting held at Fire Station 1.

Chief Maggos attended a portion of the IL Fire Chiefs Association Conference in Peoria, attending sessions on AI, Wellness Initiatives, and Community Risk Reduction. He also received his 25-year pin.

Retired firefighter Art Shuett stopped by Station 1 this month where he was formally honored by placing his badge on our new retiree display case.

Three public events were held at Fire Station 2 this month; the 31st Street Corridor Transportation Public Open House, the second Neighborhood Dialogue, and the Haunted Trolley Open House.

Incidents of Interest

The FD responded to a two-family dwelling in the 300 block of N. La Grange Rd. where a resident fell asleep and left a candle heating in a pot on the stovetop overnight with the burner on. The candle melted down and a pool of wax caught fire. Luckily, (as there was no working smoke detector), the resident awoke to the fire, along with her young daughter, and was able to fight the fire with her sprayer from the sink. There was damage to the range and ventilation fan above, and soot throughout the living unit. Firefighters shut off gas, deenergized the range and fan, and also provided and installed a new smoke alarm for the tenant prior to leaving the scene.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT – October 2025

Ambulance Responses:

This month, EMT and Paramedic personnel responded to a total of 134 requests for emergency medical services treating a total of 138 patients. There were 98 calls located west of the IHB Railroad and 18 calls east of the IHB Railroad. We gave mutual 17 times and received it 16 times. Year to date there has been a total of 1,733 requests for emergency medical services caring for a total of 1,746 patients.

This compares to last year (October 2024) when there were 169 requests for service treating 166 patients and year to date totals were 1,581 requests for service treating 1,580 patients.

Training and Continuing Education:

Continuing Education for the month of October was postponed due to IDPH having to approve the new SOP updates.

Special Activities:

Ambulance 1214 provided ambulance coverage for the Nazareth Academy football game on 10/10/2025 and 10/24/2025.
